At approx. 10:45 a.m. on the aforementioned date, while exiting the building, Patrolman Mark Dunleavy's attention was drawn to an unfamiliar motor vehicle he observed quickly pulling away from the employee parking lot located at the rear of the Douglas Police station. The vehicle was seen leaving the property in a manner that suggested its occupant(s) were trying to avoid being noticed. Officer Dunleavy was able to maintain visual sight of the vehicle and initiated a stop of it on Gilboa Street after observing a civil infraction.

Carlos AS Almeida was identified by Officer Dunleavy as the operator of the motor vehicle. During his conversation with Officer Dunleavy and Lt. Miglionico who arrived to assist, Mr. Almeida gave several inconsistent, varying explanations for why he was in the employee parking lot at the police department. Further investigation revealed that Mr. Almeida was in possession of a large quantity of controlled substances in addition to several hundred dollars in cash.

Mr. Almeida was placed under arrest and taken into custody. He was transported to the Douglas Police Department where he was booked accordingly. Mr. Almeida was held overnight at the police station on \$10,000.00 cash bail. He was subsequently transported to the Uxbridge District Courthouse the following morning.
