Date: Monday, February 16, 2009

Defendant: Michael J. FEARING; age 47 of 46 George Street, Mendon, MA

Incident: O.U.I. Alcohol; 3rd Offense, Marked Lanes Violation

At approximately 9:56 p.m. on the aforementioned date, Patrolman Raymond Majeau stopped a sport utility vehicle on Main Street, Rte. 16. The vehicle matched the description given by another motorist who reported an erratic operator on Webster Street, Rte. 16. After further investigation, Officer Majeau placed the operator, Michael J. Fearing under arrest for Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol, 3rd Offense. Mr. Fearing was also cited for a marked lanes violation. Mr. Fearing was held in custody until his arraignment in Uxbridge District Court on Tuesday morning. Officer Majeau was assisted by Sgt. Greg Gilbert.

At approximately 12:40 a.m., Sgt. Brett Fulone and Officer George Degenova stopped a motor vehicle after Sgt. Fulone observed it traveling westbound on Main Street, Rte. 16 at a high rate of speed. The operator was identified as Julius T. Allard of Providence, Rhode Island. After further investigation, officers located approx. 3.8 ounces of marijuana inside the vehicle along with packaging material and a scale. As a result, Mr. Allard was placed under arrest for the charges listed above. He was held in custody until his arraignment in Uxbridge District Court on Tuesday morning.
