**Involved: Meghan M. WINCHELL(BURBURY), Kevin F. WINCHELL Jr., Joseph H. SMITH, Jeffrey P. TEBO**

**Incident: Assault and Battery, Fight/Disturbance**

At 10:56 p.m. Douglas Officers responded to 6 Gilboa Street after receiving several E-911 calls reporting a large fight involving several combatants. Callers reported one of the involved participants was down on the ground as a result. Officers arrived moments later to find two of the involved with serious injuries and a third with minor injuries.

The involved were identified as the following:

Kevin F. WINCHELL Jr., age 29 of 124 South Street, Douglas, MA;

Jeffrey P. TEBO, age 33 of 6 Gilboa Street, Apt. B, Douglas, MA

Mr. Tebo and Mr. Smith were transported by Douglas ambulances to Hubbard Hospital in Webster and Milford Hospital respectively. Officers spoke with several witnesses at the scene and learned that a physical confrontation took place in the parking lot behind 6 Gilboa Street after Meghan and Kevin Winchell and Joseph Smith arrived there by vehicle looking for Tebo.

The investigation is ongoing at this time. Police expect to bring charges as a result. Investigating officers are Sgt. Brett Fulone, Patrolman Aaron McLaughlin, Patrolman Anthony Yannino, Sgt. Gregory Gilbert and Patrolman Raymond Majeau.

**Incident: O.U.I. Alcohol, Marked Lanes Violation**
