PRESS RELEASE

Date: Sunday, April 26, 2009

Defendant: Tyson S. GRAY; age 20 of 76 Southwoods Drive, Uxbridge, MA 01569

Incident: O.U.I. Alcohol, Negligent Operation of a Motor Vehicle, Speeding, Minor Transporting Alcohol

At approximately 12:10 a.m. Patrolman Anthony Yannino was dispatched to the area of Riedell Road in response to a report of vandalism in the area. While on West Street, Officer Yannino located evidence of the vandalism in the roadway. As his investigation continued, Officer Yannino encountered a vehicle which appeared to elude him by accelerating onto Cross Street as he prepared to stop it. While attempting to relocate the vehicle-in-question, Officer Yannino came across it after it had crashed onto a stone wall in front of 14 Cross Street. The vehicle had come to rest in the middle of the roadway and had sustained heavy damage.

Officer Yannino identified the operator as 20 year old Tyson S. Gray of Uxbridge. Through further investigation, Officer Yannino discovered evidence of Mr. Gray's intoxication at the crash scene. In addition, Mr. Gray was found to be in possession of several 12 oz. cans of beer which were located within his vehicle. Mr. Gray was placed under arrest at the scene. He was transported to Milford Hospital by Douglas Ambulance as a result of the crash where he was treated and released. Upon his return to the Douglas Police Department, he was processed and subsequently released on bail later that morning pending his arraignment in Uxbridge District Court.

Incident: Warrant Arrest
