PRESS RELEASE

Date: Thursday, May 21, 2009

Defendant: Carlos M. CUEVAS; age 39 of 1 River Ave., Apt. 3, Southbridge, MA 01550

Incident: Operating a Motor Vehicle w/a Suspended License, Subsq. Offense

At 6:29 p.m., Patrolman Jacob Bloniasz stopped a vehicle on Davis Street, Rte. 16 for an inspection sticker violation. The operator was identified as Mr. Cuevas. A check of Mr. Cuevas' license through the MA R.M.V. revealed that his right to operate a motor vehicle was suspended. A further check of Mr. Cuevas' criminal history found that he had been charged previously for the same violation.

Mr. Cuevas was placed under arrest and taken into custody. He was taken to the Douglas Police Department where he was subsequently bailed and released. Patrolman Raymond Majeau assisted.

Date: Monday, May 25, 2009

Defendant: Stephen A. STACHURA; age 20 of 3 Blanchard Drive, Millbury, MA 01527

Incident: O.U.I. Alcohol, Defective Equipment

At approximately 2:57 a.m., Patrolman Anthony Yannino stopped a vehicle on Gilboa Street after observing it being operated with defective equipment. Officer Yannino soon identified the operator as Mr. Stachura and while having conversation with him, detected the odor of alcohol coming from within the vehicle. Patrolman Yannino conducted a series of field sobriety tests with Mr. Stachura, concluding that he was operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol.

Mr. Stachura was placed under arrest and taken into custody without incident. He was booked accordingly and subsequently released on personal recognizance.

A passenger in Mr. Stachura's vehicle, identified as **20 year old Keegan James Barnicle of 89 Prospect Street, Whitinsville, MA** was found to be intoxicated and was taken into protective custody. Mr. Barnicle was later released into the custody of his parents. Officer Matthew Nadeau assisted Officer Yannino with the arrests.

Defendant: Francisco RONDON; age 32 of 60 Park Terrace Road, Worcester, MA 01604

Incident: Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle, Child 5-12 w/out Seat Belt

At 5:20 p.m., while monitoring vehicular traffic on Wallum Lake Road, Patrolman Travis Gould observed a black Nissan sedan bearing MA reg. 8911TW exit Wallum Lake State Park and pass by his location. As it did, Officer Gould observed an unrestrained child sitting on the lap of one of the back-seat passengers. A check of the vehicle's registration revealed that the owner had an expired MA license. Officer Gould stopped the vehicle and identified the operator as Mr. Rondon. He soon confirmed that Mr. Rondon was operating without an active license. As a result, Mr. Rondon was issued a criminal complaint for the aforementioned charges. Arrangements were made for a licensed driver to take over the vehicle's operation and the 7 year-old child was restrained properly before they were allowed to leave.

Incident: Warrant Arrest

Mr. Bourque was denied bail and he was subsequently transported to the Uxbridge District Courthouse upon release.
